



PRAKASAM -LEVEL 2(Second Year) – 3 Quarters

Vocabulary

- 2.1 Read and write sentences using vocabulary words from previous year. Build on consonant digraphs, phonetics, and emphasis on pronunciation, vowels, and consonants, blending of vowels with consonants. Read stories, write sentences, and focus on speaking skills, build on comprehension, poems.
- 2.2 Build on comprehension, vocabulary, and poems, read lessons, moral stories, moral poems
- 2.3 Read poems, write meaningful sentences, idioms, riddles, proverbs, focus on conversation using vocabulary words, initiate basic conversation, read stories and write short answers, moral stories, moral poems, samslesha aksharaalu (blending of a consonant with 2 digraphs), jumbled phrases, words with uncommon alphabets

Grammar

- 2.1 Introduction of parts of Speech- Noun, Pronoun, and question words, masculine, feminine, common gender, singular, plural.
- 2.2 Parts of Speech- revise first quarter topics, adjectives, and verb, past, present and future tenses, synonyms, antonyms, riddles
- 2.3 Preposition, idioms, exclamatory marks, proverbs, exclamatory words, verbs and tenses, adjectives, adverbs, gender, singular, plural, revision of topics from previous quarters

Culture

- 2.1 Short stories related to historical places, biographies of famous people from Andhra Pradesh
- 2.2 Popular places, various art forms
- 2.3 Famous people, popular places

By the end of the year, students are able to read short stories and write answers in their own words. Emphasis is on reading fluency and comprehension through stories and end of the lesson exercises. Students develop the skills to talk on a few impromptu topics. Students converse in Telugu during class activities.
